Peregrine Now Offers Part 27 AML STC for Garmin GTX 330ES Transponders

On December 1st, Peregrine received STC approval for an ADS-B Out solution using the Garmin GTX 330ES or GTX 33H w/ES transponders for several Part 27 rotorcraft models. The STC allows for the transponder to be paired with either the Garmin GTN series or the GNS 400W/500W series navigators.

Peregrine's STC meets the ADS-B Out mandate which goes into effect January 1, 2020. This affordable solution allows many rotorcraft operators with the option to obtain ADS-B Out functionality through a simple upgrade of the existing Garmin transponder and GPS equipment.

This STC was developed in partnership with Air Methods to support upgrade of their vast fleet of air medical transport helicopters for compliance to the FAA ADS-B mandate.

"We are pleased to provide this cost-effective solution to a previously underserved, yet critical segment of the aviation industry. As the deadline approaches, rotorcraft operators will be appreciative to see this option available," said TJ Spitzmiller, Peregrine's Director of Program Management.
